The Online Safety Act 2023

As many of you will be aware I write with regular updates on Online Safety across the academy, I am pleased to announce the introduction of the new legislation 'The Online Safety Act' passed in October 2023.

Please find attached a guide to help support you and your child to understand the new legislation. This new legislation "aims to establish major new layers of protection for children when they're online. The government has pledged a zero-tolerance approach to protecting children from online harm' and the act certainly includes more powerful legislation which should help to safeguard young people in the digital world." "The act states that 'social media sites must rapidly remove illegal and/or harmful content such as bullying, harassment, pornography or content that supports extremist activity or encourages or depicts violence, suicide, self-harm or eating disorders. If they fail to do so, they can be fined up to 10% of their global revenue, while their executives may even face jail time."

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you, if a student feels that any online communication is not kind or appropriate, it is important to report it to a trusted adult. Students are encouraged to speak with their PT in the first instance, we also have pastoral support available to help. If students would prefer to report via email, they can use refernow@universityofkentacademiestrust.org.uk or via the student support app on their iPad.

If you are concerned about material on the internet, you should report your concerns and the information to the social media platform. In addition, you can report to the following agencies who will take steps to remove it from the internet and investigate.
