I am pleased to confirm with you that students will be able to collect their GCSE Statistic results on Thursday 20th August at Chatham Grammar, in the main hall. To reduce the number of students in the academy at any one time in line with social distancing guidelines, students have been allocated a time slot to collect their results based on their surname as follows:

All students should arrive at the main hall external doors opposite reception and use the social distancing queue system prior to entering. It is important that all students attend during their allocated time slot only as results will not be available at alternative times during the morning.

Due to current building work we are unable to accommodate parking on site as usual. However, we have arranged for the Ash Tree Lane entrance to be open where you will be directed to park on the school field. Alternatively, you will need to enter the site on foot via the pedestrian gate opposite St Augustine's church.

If a student is unable to collect their results, the student should email our exam secretary Mrs Nevin, via nevin@universityofkentacademiestrust.org.uk. Students will need to give permission for either someone to collect their results on their behalf or if they wish their results to be posted. Unfortunately, we are not permitted to post these results until 8am on the day. If a person is collecting results on behalf of a student, please note they will need to bring ID on the day.
