Term 2 update

I hope this finds you and your family safe and well. I wanted to update you on our focus for Term 2 with a few reminders.

Year 11 Study Café

The Study Café continues this term. It is a supervised and focused environment for students to be able to complete some independent revision and seek support and help with revision strategies if needed. Students will need to bring their revision materials with them for the subject they are choosing to focus on in the session. Many students are using this support which is great to see!

November assessments

As you are aware, your child is currently sitting their first round of mini mock exams this month. Students have been briefed in how these first mock exams will run and they are encouraged to either speak to their Personal Tutor or me if they have any worries or concerns. Our aim is to replicate the summer exams so students are as comfortable with the experience as they can be.

Summer 2022 examinations

Whilst there is obvious uncertainty created by Covid 19, we anticipate that your child will sit their GCSE examinations in the summer term. In my last letter to you, we were waiting to hear the results of an Ofqual consultation that closed in July. These have been announced and the link below explains the changes and contingency plans. Please be aware that this information was released to schools on 11th November and schools are working their way through the practicalities of the arrangements.
