Term 3 Update

As we begin our third term of the year, I wanted to take the opportunity to send you some updates and highlight key upcoming dates and events.

COVID Testing

Thank you for your ongoing support with Lateral Flow Testing at home. The majority of students had consent for testing on Tuesday and Wednesday this week, with only one positive result, which is yet to be confirmed by PCR. Although the guidance changed to only offer one test onsite we decided to plan for two, however, with the high uptake but low cases we do not feel there is a need for the second test onsite. You are also now aware from yesterday's letter that on Monday we have the next set of vaccines being offered on site.

Students should continue to test regularly (at least twice weekly) using the lateral flow home test kits that are distributed to students on an ongoing basis. The next supply of home test kits will be sent home with students during the week beginning 10th January. Additional home test kits are available from Student Services and we encourage students to ensure they have a good supply to allow them to continue testing on a regular basis.

Term 2 events

During the final week of Term 2 we had a number of exciting and successful events taking place across the student houses and it proved to be an enjoyable week for all. A huge well done to all of our students who took part in the planning and delivery of events including our Christmas markets, student choir carol service and house charity fundraiser activities. In addition to these, students also took part in visits to the pantomime in Chatham, watched our very own staff panto here at Chatham Grammar, were invited to evening Christmas cinema screenings and a disco to finish the week off.

Remote learning

As a school we are working hard to ensure that covid has minimal disruption to regular classes and are also planning ahead for any changes that may occur going forward. Year 11 February/March mock exams

The next set of mock exams will run from Monday 7th February until Friday 4th March. These mocks will mirror the public exams and therefore students will be sitting multiple papers for each subject. A timetable will be issued to your child in the same format as before.

Year 11 support sessions

A new timetable of support sessions begins this term following the results of their November 'mini mocks'. This is to increase the personalisation of support we offer to year 11 this academic year. To support your child in their preparation for their next mock exams many subject specific sessions are being held for students this term, either before or after school. Due to the limited time available in the working week you will notice that some sessions are delivered in the morning and after school. There will naturally be more than one subject running sessions on any given day. It is therefore key that your child communicates with their class teacher to identify which sessions are most pertinent to them on a weekly basis.
