At Chatham Grammar we have a curriculum designed to provide a stimulating education for all students. We believe it places education at the heart of the learning community and provides equality of opportunity and access for all.

Students will need to inform their preferences with the knowledge that at the end of Year 8 students will select from these choices which language they wish to specialise in Year 9 and take through to GCSE level.

All languages follow the same structure and content.

During the year students will:

- Develop the language skills acquired during Year 7 to communicate using the four key skills of speaking, reading, writing and listening.
- Students continue to learn about the culture and way of life in French, German or Spanish speaking countries.
- Develop language skills through a variety of teaching techniques which will provide a solid basis for the future study of languages.
